

## JOB DESCRIPTION

### **Department Chair at EHESP – French School of Public Health, Environmental and Occupational Health Sciences Campus of Rennes, Brittany, France**

EHESP – French School of Public Health ([www.ehesp.fr](http://www.ehesp.fr)) is a major actor for postgraduate training and research in Public Health in France and in Europe. It seeks to hire the future chair of the *Environmental and Occupational Health Sciences* Department, one of its four training and research departments. The Department is in charge of 4 master programs, one 'post-master' program and is responsible for the initial and continuous education training of all the civil servants acting as environmental health engineers and hygienists in France; it is also committed to international collaboration in its fields of excellence, for training, research and expertise. The Department faculty team is composed of 18 persons, from a wide array of disciplines, most of whom develop their research activity within the Inserm center Irset (research teams on "*Exposure Assessment and Epidemiological Research on Environment, Reproduction and Development*" and on "*Epidemiology in Occupational Health and Ergonomics*": [www.irset.org](http://www.irset.org)), or within the Cnrs unit Arènes (research team on "*Public action, territory and governance*": [www.crape.univ-rennes1.fr](http://www.crape.univ-rennes1.fr)). The Department chair stands in the EHESP Executive Committee.
