



**Director, Maryland Institute for Applied Environmental Health
Full Professor, School of Public Health**

The University of Maryland, School of Public Health located in College Park, is searching for a Director of its Maryland Institute for Applied Environmental Health (<http://sph.umd.edu/department/miaeh>). We invite applications and nominations for this tenured, full time faculty position at the Professor level. The Director will provide strategic research and academic leadership to this interdisciplinary Institute that focuses on environmental health science. The Institute seeks to promote and protect human health in the diverse communities across Maryland, the nation and the world through discovery, education, and innovative application of knowledge in the field of environmental and occupational health.

Responsibilities: The successful candidate will be expected to provide exceptional leadership and guidance to the Maryland Institute for Applied Environmental Health. The candidate is also expected to be actively involved in Institute and School-wide degree programs; extramurally funded, multidisciplinary research; teaching; and engaging in service duties as required by the School and University.

Qualifications: Applicants must have a proven scholarly track record in environmental health and be eligible for appointment as a tenured Professor. They must possess a doctorate in environmental health or other public health or biomedical science. The successful candidate will be nationally recognized as a scholar in environmental health, demonstrate strong academic and administrative experience, and have extensive expertise in securing and managing external funds to support their research program. The candidate also should have a strong commitment to faculty and staff mentoring and development, demonstrate the ability to create and sustain liaisons and partnerships with interdisciplinary teams, and possess strong interpersonal communication skills. As teaching and mentoring are important to the School, the candidate should be committed to enhancing the educational and professional development of students.

Academic Environment: The School of Public Health has six academic units: the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics; the Department of Behavioral and Community Health; the Department of Family Science; the Department of Health Services Administration; the Department of Kinesiology; and the Maryland Institute for Applied Environmental Health. The academic units offer course work, practical experiences, and research opportunities leading to Bachelor of Science degrees, a Master of Public Health, a variety of other Master degrees and Ph.D. degrees.

The University of Maryland is a research intensive land grant university. College Park is the flagship campus of the University of Maryland System with over 2,500 faculty, 27,000 undergraduate students and 10,000 graduate students. The campus is ideally located 6 miles from Washington, DC and 30 miles from the Maryland state capital, Annapolis. It is situated near a metro line that serves the Washington, DC area and is in close proximity to several federal institutes/agencies and departments including DHHS (NIH, FDA) and USDA.
