JOB DESCRIPTION

Location: **Multi Asia (Lao, Vietnam, Cambodia)**

Project: **Regional Capacity Development for Strengthening Resilience to Climate Change in the Health Sector in the Greater Mekong Subregion (formerly Mitigating Human Impact of Climate Change)**

The coordinator will provide thought leadership and strategic guidance for the entire TA and will support the development of national adaptation plans and lead high-level advocacy meetings.

The position is estimated at 20 person-months, intermittent over three years.

Tasks include:

- ensure delivery of all outputs;
- ensure proper collection of epidemiological data;
- lead planning and conduct of regional workshops;
- lead high-level advocacy meetings with the public and private sectors;
- ensure the adequacy and quality of regional training interventions;
- coordinate the preparation of prefeasibility studies;
- coordinate logistics for capacity development and knowledge sharing;
- ensure adequate communication between MOH departments and related ministries (such as environment);
- ensure monitoring of the project activities, as per the design and monitoring framework;
- ensure implementation of gender mainstreaming;
- liaise with existing coordination forums on climate change in the three countries;
- coordinate with health economist inputs for prefeasibility studies on investment opportunities for climate change adaptation in the health sector;
- coordinate inputs for prefeasibility studies, and identify possible cofinancing, including from the private sector, in cooperation with the health economist;
- prepare project reports and compile inputs of different consultants;
- participate in review missions to assess TA progress;
- supervise national consultant inputs.

- Be an accomplished public health expert
- Degree in medical sciences or equivalent
- A Master's or doctorate degree in public health, epidemiology, or equivalent
- At least 15 years of relevant experience in disease surveillance
- Excellent knowledge of climate change-related aspects in public health
- Experience in working with the public and private sectors is essential
- Excellent knowledge of written and spoken English is a must
