### ENVIRONMENTAL EPIDEMIOLOGY

Wolters Kluwer (WK), in partnership with the International Society for Environmental Epidemiology (ISEE), announces a search for Editor-in-Chief of ENVIRONMENTAL EPIDEMIOLOGY, a new open access journal to be launched in early 2017 and published alongside EPIDEMIOLOGY. As a fully open access journal, ENVIRONMENTAL EPIDEMIOLOGY will consider new submissions, as well as high-quality submissions initially considered for publication in EPIDEMIOLOGY, both pre-review and post-review. ENVIRONMENTAL EPIDEMIOLOGY will provide a global forum for the rapid publication of environmental epidemiology research in a fully open access, online environment. Fully peer reviewed and held to the same high standards of rigor as Epidemiology, the new journal will support the global community of environmental epidemiology experts by providing a venue for articles that further the understanding of all aspects of the field.

The Editor-in-Chief, selected in partnership with the ISSE, will provide leadership for the successful launch and continued development of an innovative and high quality scientific journal that serves the needs of a global environmental epidemiology community. The journal publisher (Wolters Kluwer) will provide technical support and appropriate training on the submission system and production process. Annual financial support is provided.

#### Responsibilities of the Editor-in-Chief

1. Provide the highest possible quality of scientific content
2. Organize and maintain an efficient office operation
3. Add value to papers accepted for publication
4. Encourage features and content that serve the interests of the environmental epidemiology community and address the challenges facing the field
5. Maintain good relations with associated professional societies and specifically the ISEE

Interested individuals are invited to submit a brief biographical sketch and curriculum vitae. Applicants for the position of Editor-in-Chief should have stature in the field of environmental epidemiology, a distinguished publication record, and 'gold' open access editorial experience. Applicants should provide additional information on their qualifications and vision for the journal to consider their application complete.

1. A brief statement of research interests
2. Information on editorial experience, including a description of work as an Editor, Associate Editor, and/or Editorial Board Member
3. of a of journals in a related field
4. A statement describing the reasons for your interest in this position
5. Your perspective on and experience with open access journals, and your ideas for building WK's new title, as a digital-only journal, into a valuable cutting-edge extension of EPIDEMIOLOGY
6. Ideas on ways to promote awareness of the journal and encourage submissions, taking into consideration the new journal will be a non-indexed journal to start
7. Other personal qualifications and/or comments you think may be relevant for the selection committee
